Tangible Utopia is our theme for 2026: pieces that feel personal and meaningful, that resist fast trends, and that are crafted by humans for human life. Beauty becomes essential. Form and material give shape to vision. This is furniture made to last.

Under this banner, we present Mosaico, created with Studiopepe, and two new collections by Ferriani+Sbolgi: Slide, an upholstery family, and Plié, a table series. Every piece is handmade in Portugal using European-sourced materials, and everything ships in plastic-free packaging.



Why Tangible Utopia?

So much of today's design chases novelty and ends up disposable. Our answer is simple and concrete: objects made by hand, the work of many craftspeople, with bespoke material choices and durable construction. Pieces that can live long, be loved, and belong.

What this looks like in practice We start with material integrity, We design systems that scale from compact apartments to hospitality lounges, adapting to the life around them. We source materials in Europe and produce close to home, within roughly 100 kilometers of our hub in Lisbon. And for all new launches we choose plastic-free packaging.

Dooq × Studiopepe Mosaico is a upholstery family designed by Studiopepe. built on a clear dialogue between hard bases and soft, architectural volumes. Wood joinery connects the parts with visible craft. The system offers 26 curved and linear modules that fit seamlessly, so spaces can be drawn in almost any layout while remaining coherent. The range includes sofas, armchairs, poufs, dining chairs, and bar chairs.

Slide by Ferriani+Sbolgi Slide is an upholstery collection shaped by poised geometry and human comfort. It captures movement in stillness: calm planes meeting with tailored precision, ready for everyday life at home and in hospitality settings.

Pliè by Ferriani+Sbolgi Pliè is a table collection hand crafted in nickel with rounded edges and silhouettes that seem to fold and bend. It carries a future-brutalist attitude yet feels warm to the eye. The series includes side, coffee, and console tables.

Cubo is a chair shaped by the rigorous spirit of early-20th-century design. Its geometry echoes the clarity and discipline found in the late-1920s movement toward structural purity, where form was stripped back to its essential lines. Crafted entirely from stainless steel and built from a single continuous construction, Cubo feels both archival and contemporary.

Inspired by the quiet intelligence of nature, Nest translates the weaving of birds' nests into a sculptural family of dining and bar chairs. Available in traditional Portuguese bunho, rope, or natural wood, each piece is handmade by skilled artisans. The result is light yet strong seating that celebrates organic texture and the beauty of natural materials.

Soft cage plays with the tension between linear geometry and gentle roundness. Offered as a sideboard and a bar sideboard, each piece is built in Portugal through an intensive artisanal process using burl wood, lacquered wood, and natural stone. Rich textures meet contemporary precision in a sculptural approach to storage.

The Twin pouf collection is a multifunctional trio designed to work alone or cluster as a small landscape. Built in solid wood and upholstered in fabric, the pieces shift easily between seating and table use, bringing a playful versatility to any room.

Our first showing is at Maison&Objet Paris on January 15, 2026. Pre-orders open at launch. Every piece is made to order with choices of fabrics, modules, and finishes. Lead times are available on request. Fabric and finish swatches will be available, and we are debuting a new fabric selection with these collections.

SUSTAINABILITY AND RESPONSIBILITY IN 2026

We continue the transition to plastic-free packaging across new collections. We manufacture locally in Portugal using European materials, and we design with durability and repair-minded construction principles in mind.
