The Milano Table, created in collaboration with Theia Tiles, is a celebration of craftsmanship and geometry. Fully handmade, this striking piece combines lacquered wood with meticulously crafted terracotta tiles. Its hexagonal base is clad in a harmonious arrangement of three distinct tile models, reflecting a balance of artistry and precision. The round tabletop complements the bold base, while the true centerpiece lies in the table's feet, designed as a focal point that commands attention. The Milano Table is more than furniture—it's a statement of form, texture, and timeless design.



on the rocks center table

A harmonious exploration of contrasts, the On-the-Rocks Table embodies the duality of an imagined future. Rooted in the organic yet reaching toward the sleek sophistication of modern design, this piece is a sculptural art form in itself. The hand-hammered travertine top evokes natural textures and raw beauty, while the nickel base brings a polished, futuristic elegance. Designed not merely as a functional object, but as a statement to be admired and enjoyed, On-the-Rocks invites a dialogue between the tactile and the refined, merging timeless craftsmanship with avant-garde artistry.



colin armchair

Rooted in the spirit of Organic Modernism from the 1970s, the Colin Armchair invites a moment of pause and serenity. Designed to embrace the body in comfort, this armchair reimagines the balance of form and function, encouraging relaxation in solitude or togetherness. Its sculptural silhouette highlights the interplay of soft, rounded solid wood legs and plush, inviting upholstery. A celebration of organic shapes and natural materials, Colin evokes a sense of quiet elegance while creating a space to unwind, reflect, and simply be.

Marlon by Pietro Franceschini. When pure geometry meets soft curves, something sculptural and sensual comes out. A fine dialogue between oversized legs and clean lines takes place in this piece upholstered in mohair velvet. Marlon is edgy and elegant at the same time, letting the dilemma between 'contemporary' versus 'classical' fall apart.
